

New Policy Regarding CASA and any Change in County Director by David Dumble

The CASA reporting system currently allows all County Directors 30 days after the June 30, 2000 deadline to input their final report for the county. This is the responsibility of the person who is the Director as of June 30, 2000 regardless of whether they have been Director throughout the entire July-June fiscal year. If the County Directorship changed hands during the year — on January 1, 2000 for example — the outgoing and incoming County Directors should work out between themselves how any input for events taking place before January 1, should be entered.

If the incoming County Director has any doubts or reservations about any information entered by the outgoing County Director, he or she has the authority to alter the report before submitting it once they assume the mantle as County Director. Again, the incoming County Director is the one person responsible for the content of the CASA County Director report submitted before July 30, 2000 although they are free to accept as much input from the outgoing County Director as they desire.
