**1) Professional Improvement** – Tasks of this committee include the following:

- \* **Professional Improvement** - This committee should be aware of the numerous opportunities which are available to enhance the professionalism of the membership. They should disseminate this information, together with available scholarships, as appropriate throughout the year.
- \* **Programs** – NAE4-HA has taken the initiative in stimulating regional workshops for specialized program areas. The charge of this committee would be to submit proposals for needed programs which could be undertaken on a regional basis. They assume the same role at the state level.
- \* **Diversity** – Review policies, procedures, and programs to ensure a commitment to inclusiveness and diversity within the organization. Work with elected officers and standing committee chairs to recruit potential members that represent the diversity of the 4-H Youth Development professionals in California. Promote in-service opportunities for association members that strengthen an understanding and appreciation of diversity issues.

**2) Communications and Recognition** – Tasks of this committee include the following:

- \* **Newsletter** – Responsible for collecting, reviewing, and editing articles submitted for the State Association online newsletter and “*News and Views*”, the official publication of the National Association of Extension 4-H Agents.
- \* **Public Relations and Information** – Publicity, exhibits, promotion, Extension, and coordinating activities related to the NAE4-HA annual meeting.
- \* **Member Recognition** – Determine appropriate candidates for recognition in both state and national service award programs. The preparation of proper credentials is also performed by this committee.
