

AGREEMENT FOR USE OF DISTRICT FACILITIES

Southern California Regional Liability Excess Fund Joint Powers Authority (Authority), on behalf of its member's districts, hereby enters in agreement with The Regents of the University of California (University) on behalf of the University's Cooperative Extension Programs as follows:

- 1) This agreement shall be in effect for a period of (5) years beginning July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2013.
- 2) This agreement shall apply to all Cooperative Extension Programs activities
- 3) While University is using Authority member district's facilities or equipment:

University shall defend, Indemnify and hold harmless the Authority, its respective school district, officers, employees and agents harmless from and against any and all liability, loss expense, including reasonable attorney fees, or claims for injuries or damages caused by or resulting from negligent or intentional acts, including but not limited to negligent supervision by the University, its officers, employees, or agents.

Authority shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the University, its officers, employees and agents harmless from and against any and all liability, loss expense, including reasonable attorney fees, or claims for Injuries or damages caused by or resulting from negligent or intentional acts of Authority, its respective school districts, officers, employees, or agents.

- 4) Authority's district members reserve the right to deny the use of district facilities or equipment to University or to not accept the terms of this agreement, at the district's sole discretion.
- 5) Authority agrees that the terms of the hold harmless and indemnification agreement in Section 3, above, shall supersede the hold harmless and indemnification agreement which may be contained in a district member's "USE OF FACILITIES" form unless the language in Section 3 of this agreement is specifically rejected by the member district.
