Campground Host Location: Site #1 (Gate #13 campground)

❁Will have a radio to contact the Horse Department employees if there is an emergency ❁

Campground Rules

1. 4-H and FFA Club **members must be supervised at all times** by a parent, or club leader, unless guardianship is transferred to a responsible adult for a specified length of time.
2. **No Alcohol**: 4-H and FFA rules do not allow alcohol in the campgrounds.
3. **No Dogs**: They are not allowed at the fairground.
4. Be considerate of other campers and the property at all times.
5. **Campsites should be kept clean and tidy.** (All trash must be put in the cans, or taken when you leave.)
6. Generators may be used **** **Please observe quiet time from 10 pm to 6 am** ***
Anyone returning to his or her campsite late in the evening should do so quietly.
7. **DRIVE SLOWLY** for safety, and to control noise and dust.

Camping Facility Information

Showers and restrooms are available for campers 24 hours a day.
Water is available at the two locations for camping at the fairgrounds.

- a) **Gate #13, camp area is the grassy area south of the horse barns.**
 - 28 campsites open to tents, RVs, and travel trailers. (*Reservations Required*)
 - 2 vehicles per campsite.
(Additional parking is available in the North (dirt) parking lot at Gate #11.)
 - Horses are not allowed in this camp area.
 - Camping in horse trailers is not allowed at this location.
ABSOLUTELY: NO HORSE TRAILERS in this camping area.
- b) **Gate #11, camp area is the dirt parking area north of the arena parking.**
 - Horse Trailer Camping Allowed.
 - Horses allowed.
 - **Do not tie horses to trees.** Horses damage trees by chewing and/or digging.
