

4-H Cross Club Agreement

Purpose –

Different clubs offer different projects in which a member may be interested. Allowing members to participate in projects in other clubs helps meet the needs of the members.

Terms –

Home Club: The club in which the member enrolls. The member agrees to follow its bylaws and deadlines established by this club.

Cross Club: The club that offers the project not offered by the primary club.

Agreement

There must be some coordination and agreement between the leaders of the primary club and the cross club.

By signing this agreement the Community Leaders, Project Leader (s), member and member's parent agree to the following ...

1. Acknowledgement of the reasons for the cross club activity;
2. The member agrees to follow the bylaws of the primary club;
3. The member agrees to meet the requirements for participation and completion of the cross club project;
4. The member must be enrolled in at least one project in the primary club (*Exception: if the member is enrolling in a county-wide project*);
5. Project records will be checked and signed by the cross club project leader and turned in to the member to include in their Record Book. Record Books will be turned in to the primary club by its due date;
6. Transportation to project meetings and activities is the responsibility of the member and his/her parent.
