The 4-H Camp Leadership Project starts soon, if you will be 14 years old by June 1, you can participate! Youth leaders for the Las Posadas 4-H Camp will be selected from Camp Leadership Project participants. If you want to join the camp staff, you must participate in the Camp Leadership Project AND **bring the attached, completed and signed Camp Leadership Application, Medical Release and Code of Conduct forms to your first training session.** Staff members will be chosen at the end of the leadership training, and selection and assignments will depend on the applicant's areas of interest as well as attendance, participation, cooperation and skills demonstrated during the training program. Past camp participation and leadership may also be considered.

Project participants not selected for camp staff, if they have not turned 16 years old by June 1, are encouraged to come to camp as campers.

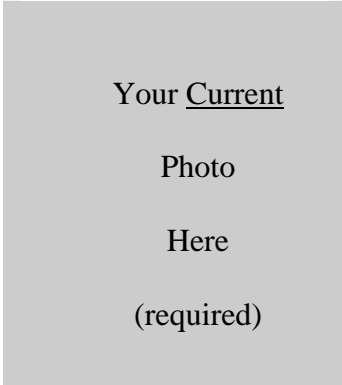
