

Instructions for using the International Tree Failure Database form with CTFRP

1. Download and read the ITFD User Manual before filling in the form
2. Be sure to fill in the fields with an asterisk such as, Tree genus* _____
3. If you do not have an ITFD password, just fill in the form and mail it to:

We continue to accept reports on the CTFRP form, but prefer that you start using the ITFD form.
